1 Introduction

for best results I recommend using a laserjet A3 printer. Use a graphics package to cut the map image in 2 and then set the two separate halves to print in the centre of A3 that has been set to print in landscape (avoid expanding the image to fit the A3 page exactly as this will distort the image, it should be just right by default). mount the two printed halves to sturdy card and stick together underneath with a hinge of tape. Folded in half the result should fit snugly in a 4th edition Talisman box!

the cards should all print to the correct size and proportion when printed out on A4. While the expansion was originally made for the 4th Edition, it should work well with any edition of Talisman. I have included cross compatible Adventure cards so that players may use the expansion with any edition of the game. I recommend that players include at least 2 of the adventure cards in their deck for the game to run smoothly however more may be added depending on the amount of additional adventure cards you already have in play.
